



By virtue of a warrant dated the 29th of January 1793 and order of survey received August 13th 1845 surveyed November 26th 1845 to Frederick Myer the above described tract of land adjoining land granted to Daniel Hicks in Lackawaxen township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County containing four hundred and fifteen acres fifteen perches and allowance of six pr. ct. for roads &c.
