



Situated in Mount-Joy township Adams County containing 94<sup>as</sup> 90 per. & the usual allowance A being part of a larger tract containing <sup>339<sup>a</sup> 139</sup> 172<sup>as</sup> 159 pr. & all. surveyed March 20<sup>th</sup> 1809 by Saml Sloan D.S. for W<sup>m</sup> & Mary Stoltz in pursuance of a warrant granted to John M<sup>c</sup> Mahon for 300<sup>as</sup> dated May 29<sup>th</sup> 1746. B is a part of a tract said to contain 240<sup>a</sup> & all. surveyed by Archl M<sup>c</sup> Clain D.S. Jan 2<sup>nd</sup> 1770 in pursuance of a location order endorsed on George Millers warrant dated July 1<sup>st</sup> 1762, & said order dated May 7<sup>th</sup> 1765. Resurvey as above specified at the request of Joseph Makley the present owner.
