

Situate in Walker township, Huntingdon county, containing seventy-eight acres, one hundred and twelve perches and allowance of six fer centum, being part of atract of land first surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Moore dated the 10th day of September, 1762, and said to contain 218, A & all This part divided from the remainder of said tract, January 23 rd, 1854, for WM Lincoln.
