



The above describes the Southern part of a tract of about 312<sup>a</sup> & allowance which was survey'd for Moses Ross originally in the year 1737. By warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> of January 1737 unto which was added the 52<sup>a</sup> & allowance above described by a later warrant as above noted, & formerly Return'd making in both 238<sup>a</sup> <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> & allowance, now in Possession of Isaac La-feber & resurvey'd for him the 24<sup>th</sup> of the 5<sup>th</sup> mo. 1788 situate in Oxford (formerly London-derry) township Chester County, Certify'd
