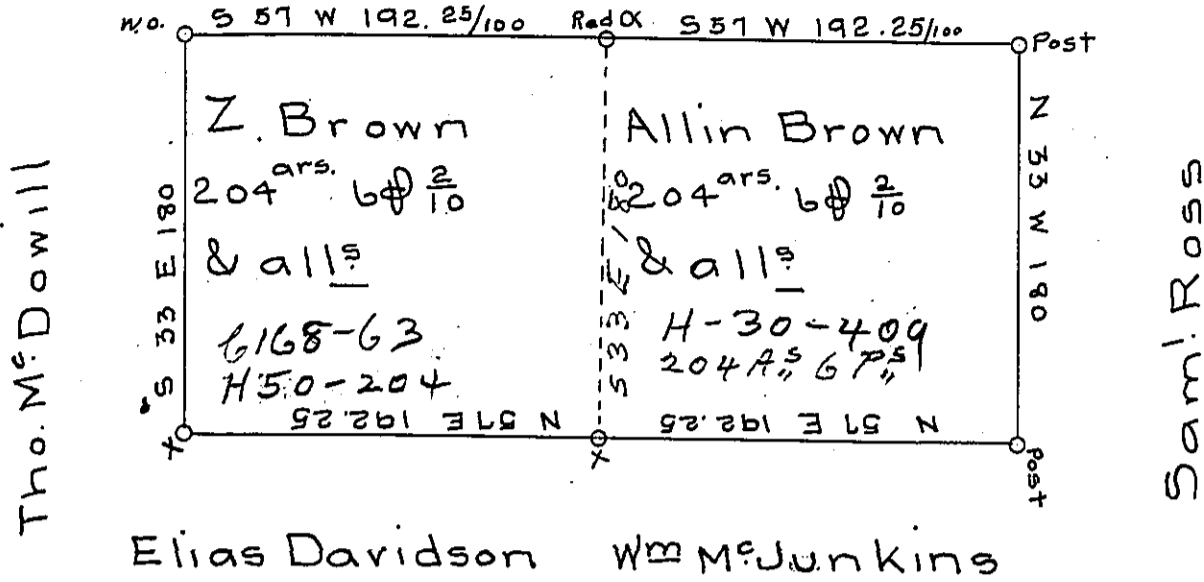

Surveyed Feb^r 24th 1827[#] for the legal representatives of John Brown deceased. The above described tract of land, containing four hundred & eight acres twelve perches & $\frac{2}{10}$ & allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ c^t. Survey^d March the 1st A.D. 1773 by virtue of a warrant granted to John Menoch for three hundred acres dated the 2nd of Dec^r 1772 & returned into the Land Office of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Situate in Plumb township Allegheny County on the waters of Plumb & Turtle creeks. The dotted line divides the tract into two allotments as represented.
