Resurveyed in pursuance of an order from the Board of Property dated October 16th 1809 granted on Petition of John Brown situate in Allegheny County on the waters of Plum run containing four hundred & fifty one acres and eighty four perches and allowance of six p. cent for roads &c.

Divided it as to lay John Menochs warrant on the head waters of Plum creek which the warrant specifies and give him land in proportion to his warrant which calls for 300 acres.
