 ance of a Warrant granted to Martha Quigley Executrix in trust for the Heirs
 of Michael Alford, dated the twelfth day of January 1810 Situate in Big
 Beaver Township Beaver County adjoining lands of John Sharp, William
 Mc George, John Mc Cready & Robert Wiley Containing 430 Acres & 28 perch-
 es and allowance of Six per Cent

 ecuting the above mentioned Warrant, there were three families residing

 cleared, fenced & cultivated
