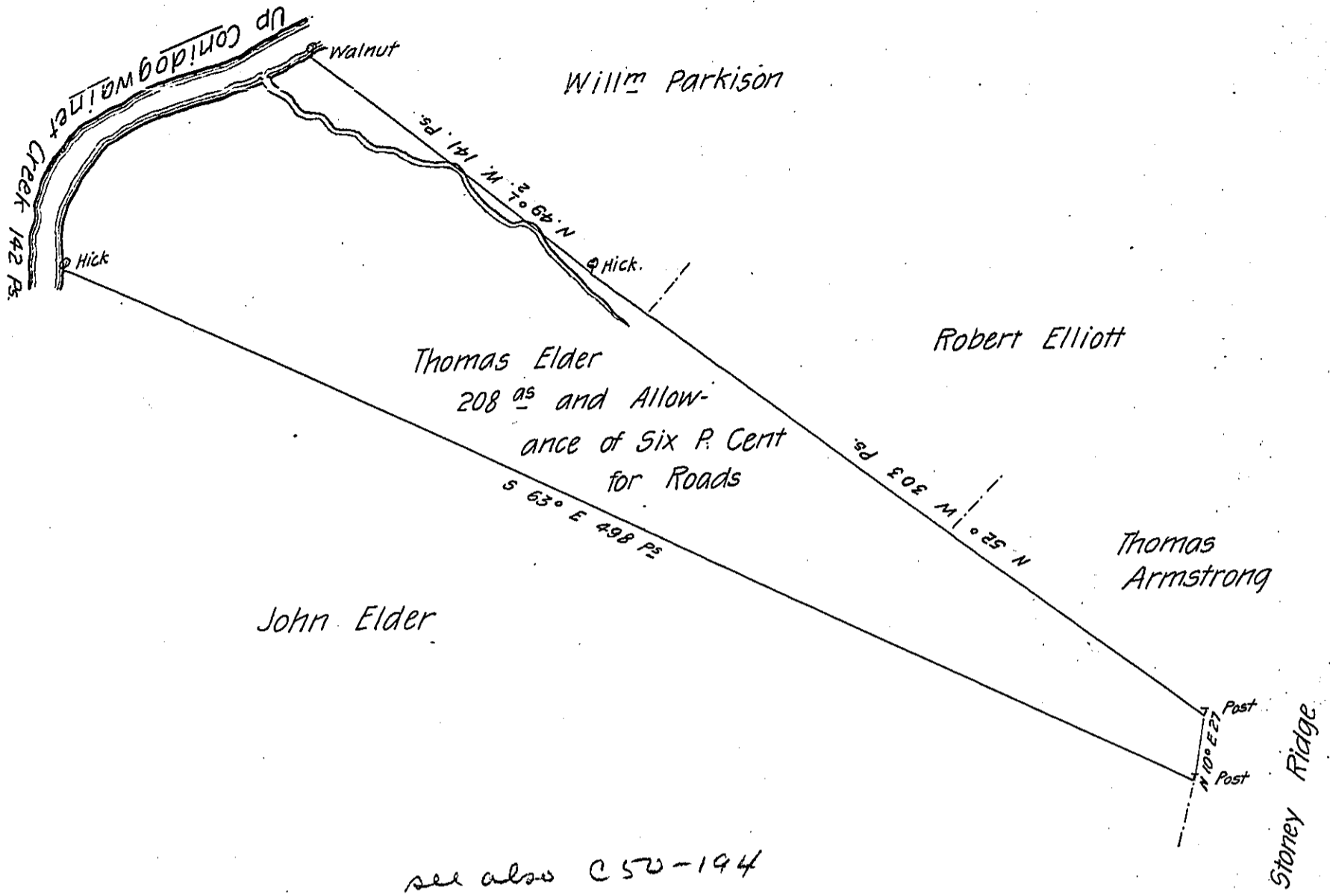

Whereas in Pursuance of a Warrant or Order from the Secretary dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1757 wherein directions was to me given to re-survey a tract of Land which Zachery Butcher Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Elder bearing date the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1738 and from said Tract to cut off and Return the Quantity of two hundred acres with the usual Allowance for Thomas Elder having been sold to him by his Brother John afore-said which was accordingly executed as will appear by the return in your Office The above is a Draught of that part of the Land which now by agreement of the Parties is re-surveyed for the said Thomas Elder the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1763 being situate in Middleton Township in Cumberland County Containing two hundred and eight Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads.
