Containing as above set forth where the letter **A** stands 11^{ac} 20 ps & allowances and where the Letter **B** stands 3^{ac} 138 per 2 and allowances &c. which are parts of 71^{ac} 34 ps & allowances &c. which was originally Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Nicholas for 50^{ac} dated the 6th day of August 1753 and since Surveyed & Divided &c. by Peter Spangler and on the 7th day of April A.D. 1837. Surveyed the above by John Becker &c. Now at the Request of John Spottz the Present I am requested to make Return thereof this 7th day of August A.D. 1837 who wishes to Patent the same &c.
