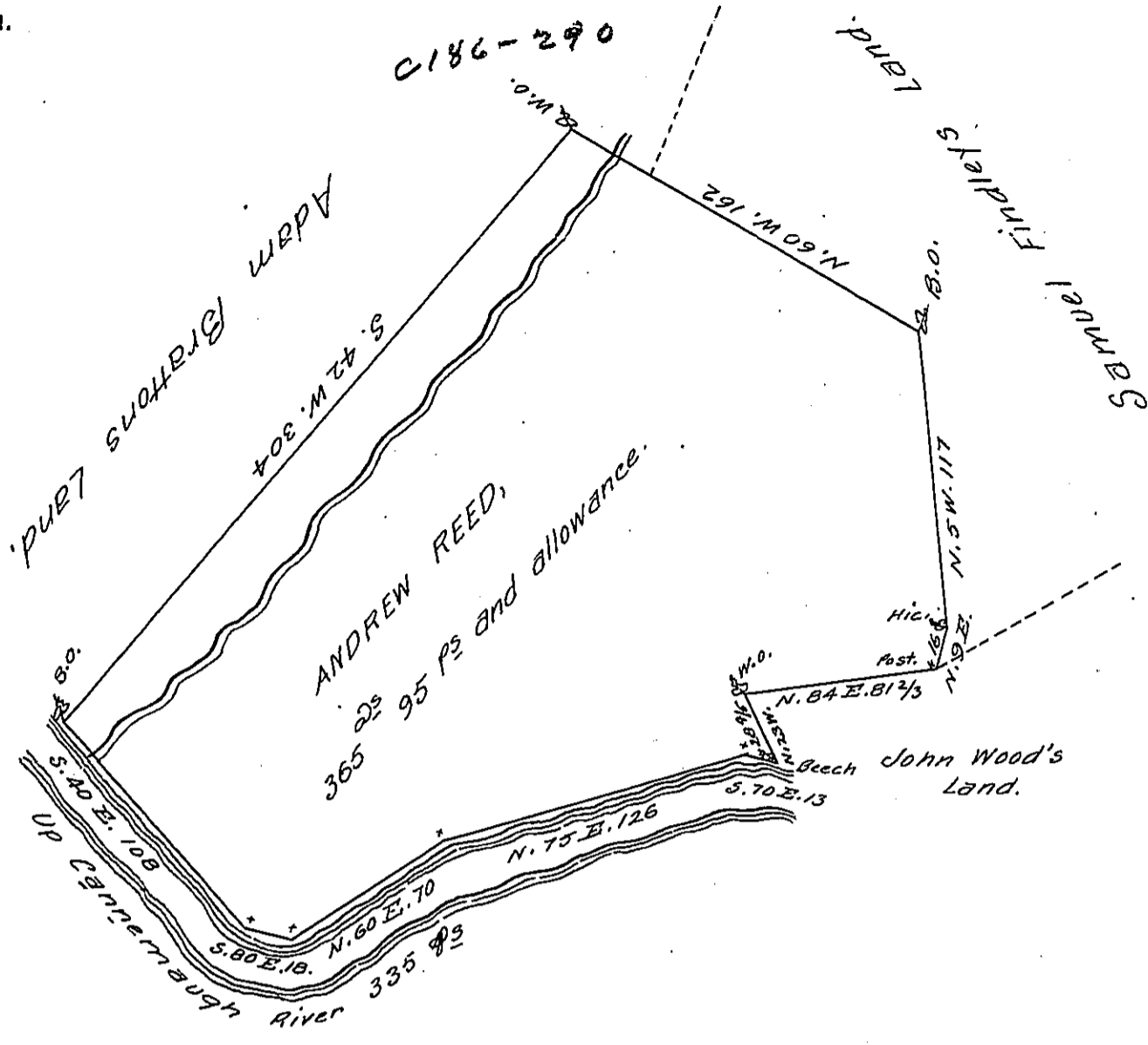


N.B. The original survey did interfere with a survey made for John Woods.

 -ance of his Warrant dated Aug^r 23^d 1784 and whereas the ^{ble} Board
 of Property by their order dated June 6th 1801. allowed that a resur-
 -vey shall take place - therefore in obedience to the said order the
 above described Tract of Land containing three hundred and sixty
 -five Acres and 95 perches with an allowance proportioned to six
 P. Cent situate in Wheatfield Township in the County of Westmore-
 -land was on the 4th March 1802 Survey'd.
