



By virtue of an application No 2282 dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1767 granted to Michael Lindermuth, John Shock, Michael Rentchler, and Jacob Wagner, in trust for the use of the Lutheran Congregation, of St. Michael Church, there was surveyed the above described tract of land, containing Thirty nine acres, one hundred & ten perches and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate in Upper-Bern township, Berks County.
