



The above is a draught of a survey made the (661)th day of January 1796 in pursuance of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners appointed to settle the Claims of unpatented lands in the Countys of Monongahala Yokogany and Ohio to John Sparr which was entered with Robert Woods Surveyor of Ohio County on the 6th day of June 1780

Situated on the waters of Chartees Creek in Washington County containing One hundred and Thirty-nine acres and One hundred and nine perches ~~and~~ strict measure
