



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> of January 1785. Surveyed the 12. Novem<sup>r</sup> 1786, to Thomas Palmer the above described tract of Land situate on the head-of Peter Quick's Saw Creek, about a quarter of a mile from-Delaware--- and a quarter-from Bailey's Sawmill in Northampton County. Containing four hundred Acres, 150 perches and the Allowance of Six  $\frac{7}{8}$  Cent 8c<sup>d</sup>
