



In pursuance of two orders N° 862 and 1035 date the third of April 1769 Surveyd for W^m Irwin and William Gibson, Surgeon, the above Described Tract of Land. Containing Six Hundred & Seventy three Acres & 107 perches, with an Allowance proportioned to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. Situate on the North Side of Loyalhanning Creek, about Ten Miles from the Chesnut Ridge & 35 Miles from Fort Pitt now in Westmorland County. Surveyd the 2^d of June 1770.
