



Situate on the Cove creek in Colerain township Bedford county containing two hundred and forty acres with the usual allowance of Six Per Cent &c Surveyed for Gerrard Pendergrass junior the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1787 in pursuance of a Warrant dated May 31<sup>st</sup> 1762. Taken from the fields notes late Deputy Surveyor of Bedford County April 11<sup>th</sup> 1792
