



Situate on Shaver's Mill run & the Glade Road in Somerset Township, Somerset County & Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1812 in pursuance of two Warrants, the first dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1793 granted to Frederick Peacher for 100<sup>ac</sup>. The 2<sup>nd</sup> dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 1794 Granted to Jacob Prindle for (61) acres. who Since purchased from Frederick Peacher as appears by the Official Draughts of John McClean Esq D.S. remaining in my Office & represented as above. Certified & returned this 20<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> A.D. 1832.
