



A Draught of a tract of land Situate partly in the Township of Lenox in the County of Susquehanna & partly in the Township of Nicholson in the County of Wyoming, adjoining lands of Andrew Gardenier and lands of the heirs of John J Marcy Decd on the East, land of John Buck on the South, by a tract No 2 in the Warrentee name of Amos Taylor on the West, and by vacant lands on the North. Surveyed the 16th day of November 1843 for Elisha Phinny in pursuance of a Warrent bearing date the Sixth day of November A 1843. Containing one hundred and nineteen acres & Seventy five perches and the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. containing also an improvement Commenced about the first of May 1793.
