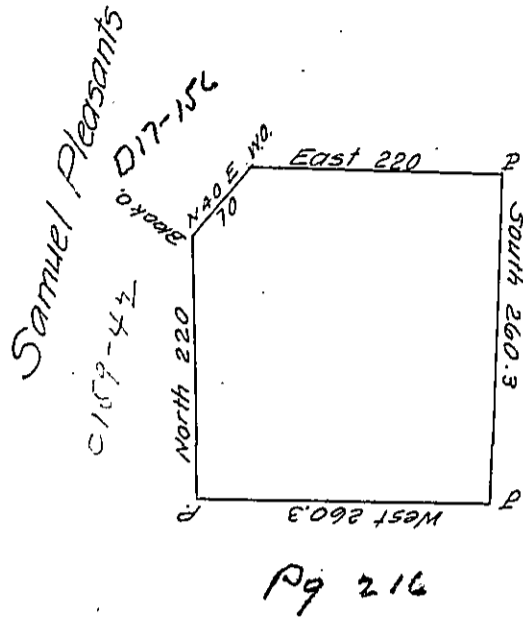

The above is the draught of a Survey made March 25th 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Andrew Porter on the 14th day of April 1792 Situate North west of the Ohio River on the Waters of Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to Samuel Pleasants called Daneberg containing 395 acres & 57 perches with the usual allowance of 6 P Cent &c
