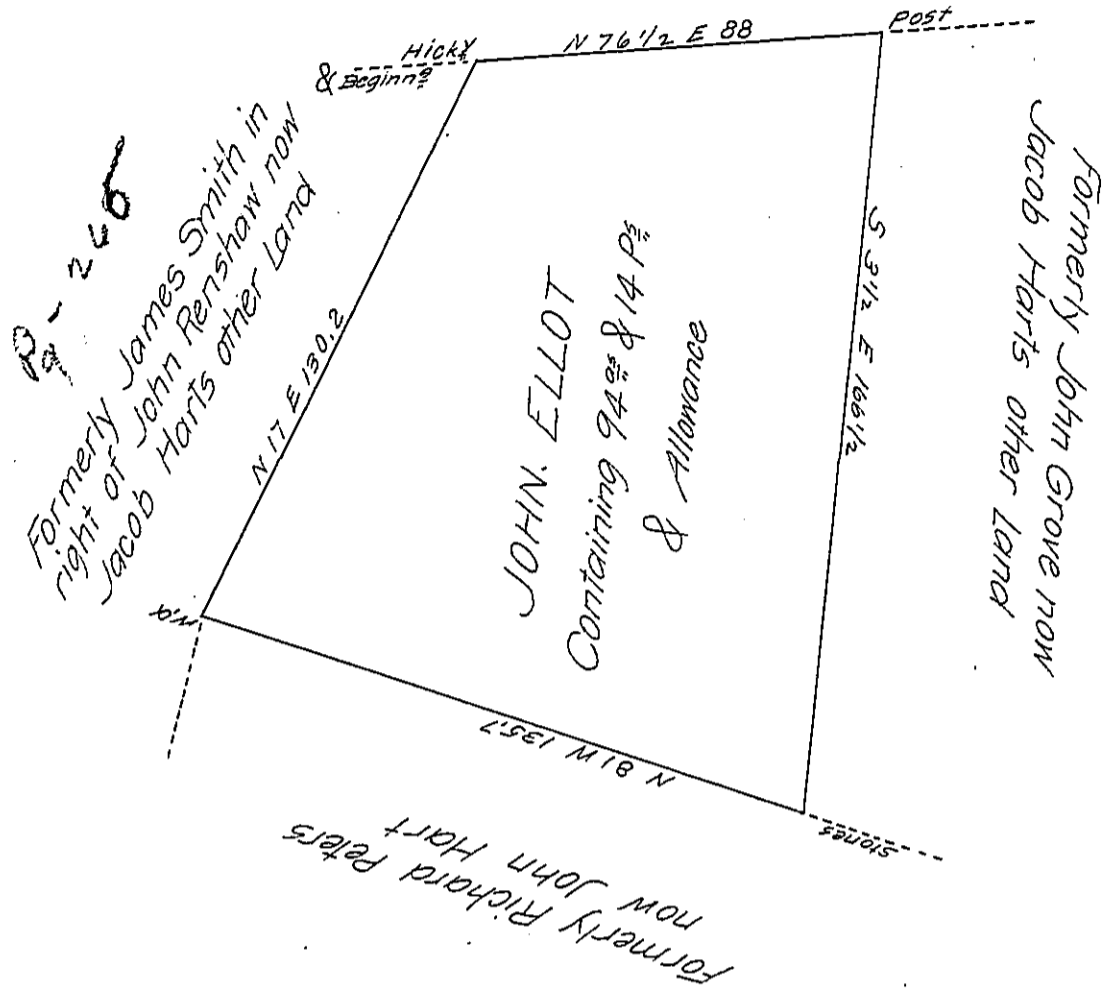

Re-surveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. on the 16th day of June 1791 for Jacob Hart the present owner at whose request I am desired to make return of the Draught for confirmation as the same has been calculated examined and found to be correct January 2^d A.D. 1821.
