



Situate in Saltlick township & County of Fayette on the North Side of the Turkey foot Road and on the waters of Indian Creek Surveyed on the 8th day of April A.D. 1840. In pursuance of a warrant in the name of William Palmer for 400 Acres dated the 30th day of January 1794. I have computed the above Survey to contain One hundred & sixty acres & One hundred & ten perches & the allowance of 6 p.c. It appears to have been improved about 40 years has 50 or 60 acres cleared, and a Dwelling house, Bar & Sawmill erected thereon It is now in the occupancy of, and claimed by William Kesler.
