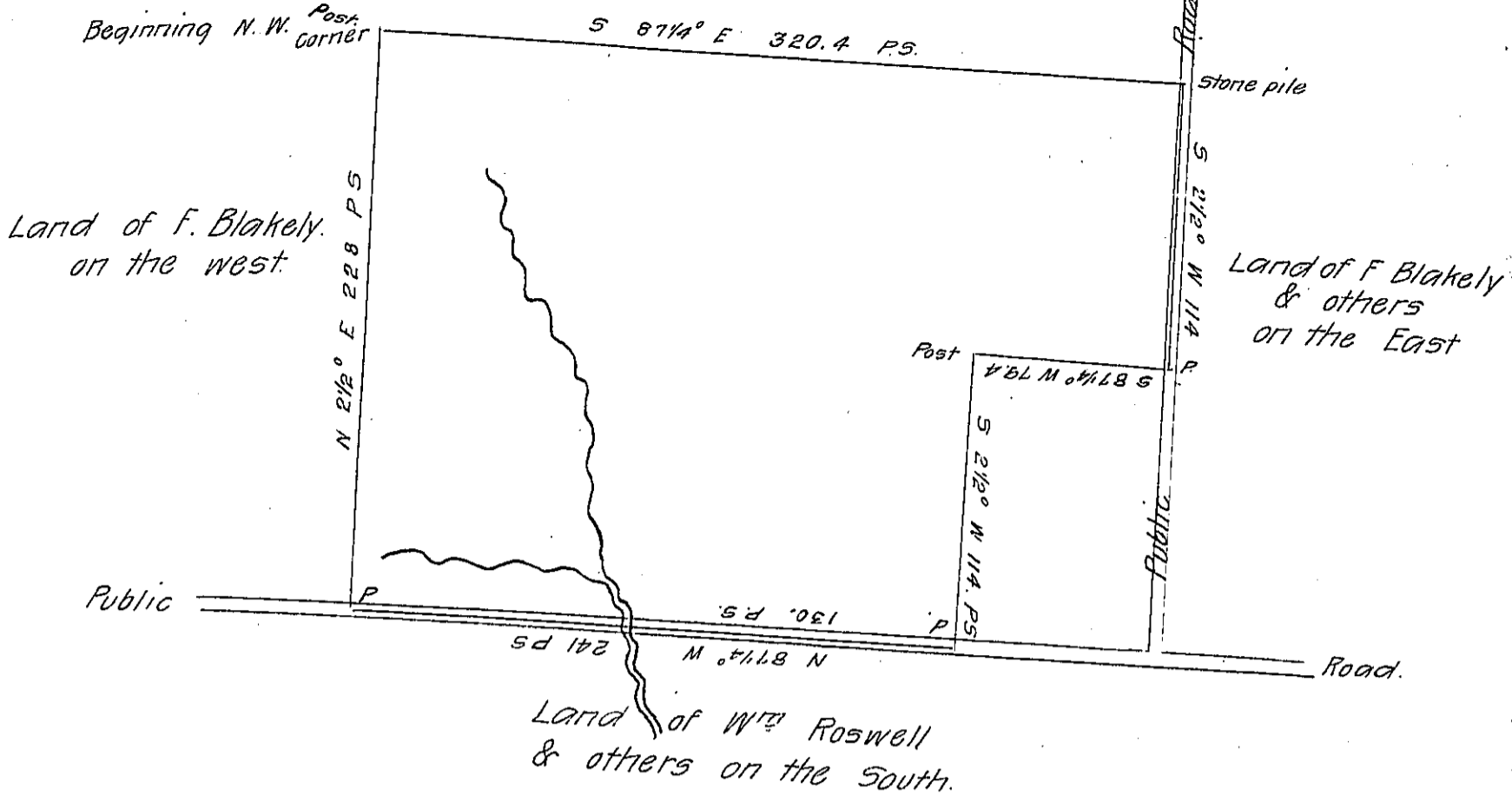


Land of W^m Smith & others on the North.
