Beg at a post & s the South East Corner of Stowell & Wilson Tract formerly Jane Young tract Thence North 1 deg. East 35 1/2 perches to P & S. Thence South 89° East 34.5 to P & S. Thence by land J. H. Neill (now Rosenbauch) South 1° West 35.5 to White Oak Thence by land formerly—Birchfield North 89° West 34.5 to Post & S place of Beg.
