



Situate in Reading Township Adams County Surveyed October 10<sup>th</sup> 1811 In pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Neely for 130<sup>a</sup> Dated March 5<sup>th</sup> 1811. Containing one hundred & thirty two acres one hundred & thirty three perches & all<sup>cs</sup>. the time of the first improvement of this tract I have not been able to ascertain, but some of the land adjoining it was warranted in the year 1743 this tract although it is level & most of it smooth yet is not of as good a quality as the plantations between it & Conewago — and probably not improved so early.
