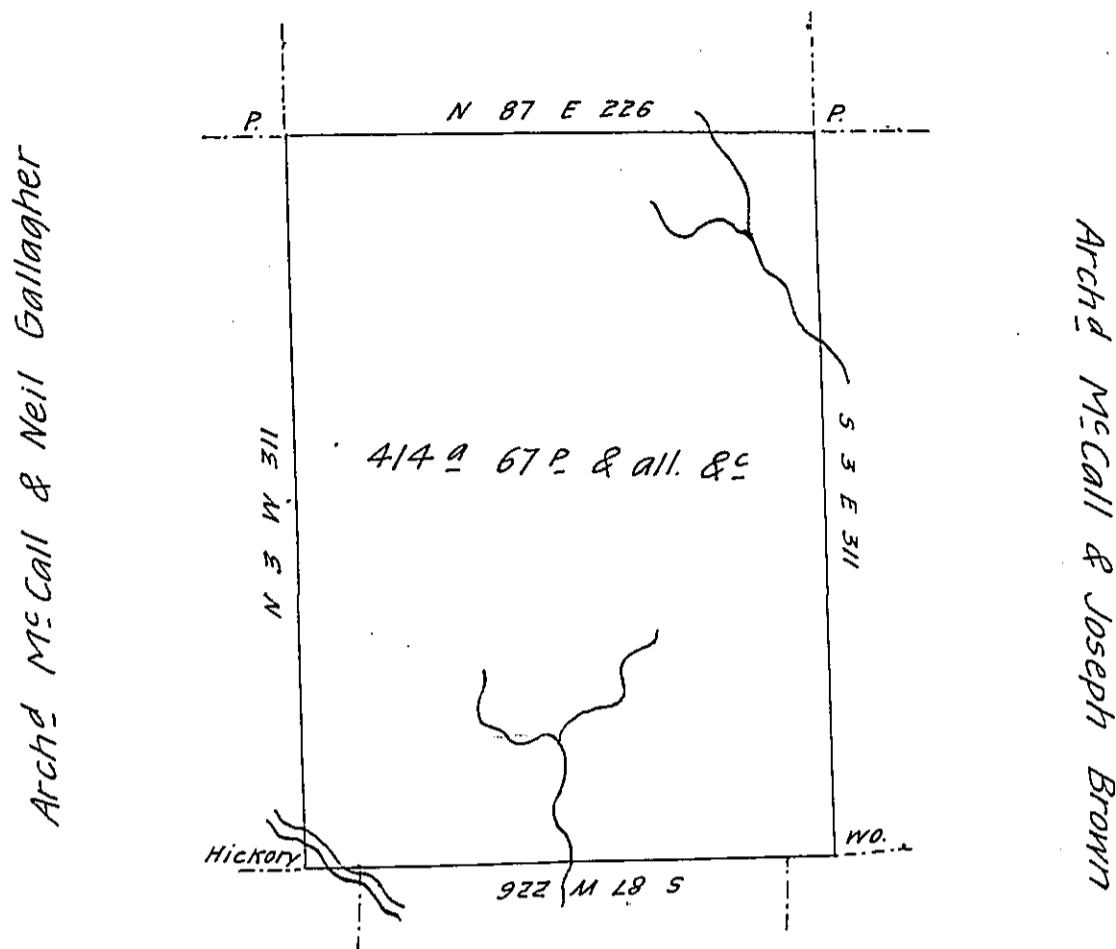


Archibald McCall

Surveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> June 1808 in pursuance of a Warrant for four hundred acres, granted to Archibald McCall & Marcus McLaughlin, dated 12<sup>th</sup> May 1808.
