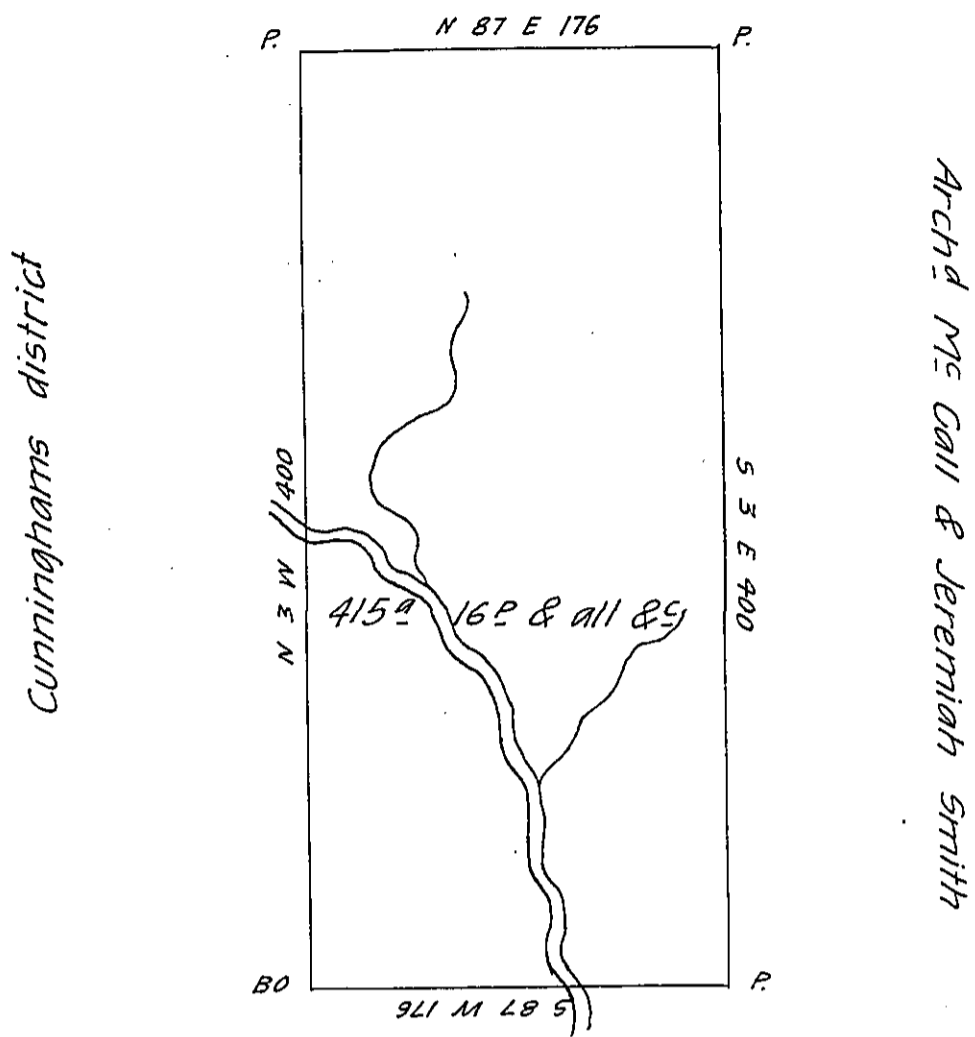


Archibald McCall

A draft of a tract of land situate on a branch of Buffalo Creek in Butler County, containing four hundred and fifteen acres & sixteen perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> June 1808 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Archibald McCall and Benjamin Server for four hundred acres, dated the 12<sup>th</sup> May 1808.
