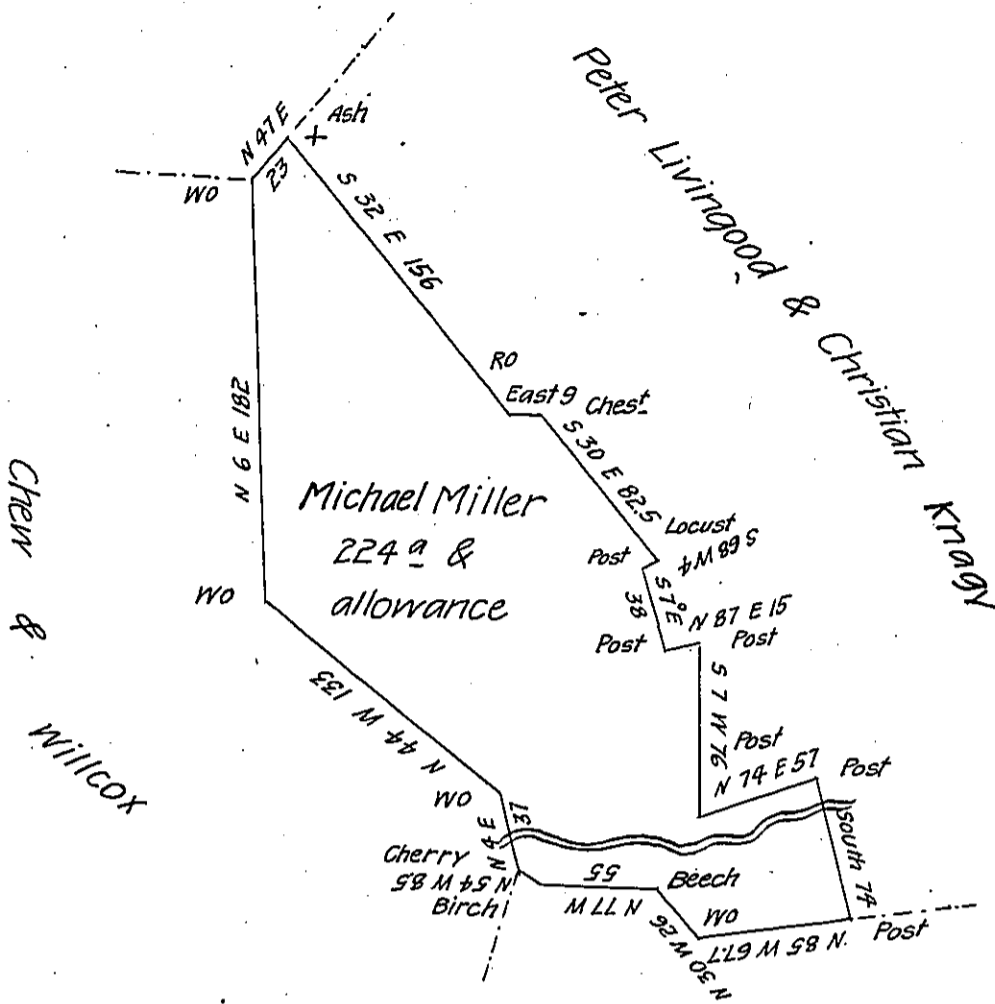

S. as appears by his official draught remaining in my office in pursuance of a warrant granted unto Michael Miller dated the 6th day of February 1790 and certified the 9th day of November 1808.
