



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 28 April 1752 and in obedience to two orders of the Board of Property dated respectively the 2 May & 3<sup>d</sup> October 1796 Resurveyed the 25 November 1796 (agreeable to the old lines and corners found round the same) the above described tract of land to Henry Ritter situate in Penn Township Northampton County containing two hundred and twenty seven acres one hundred and seventeen perches and the allowance of six P. Cent &c<sup>a</sup>. Note the piece marked 117<sup>a</sup> 76<sup>p</sup> is claim'd by Benja<sup>m</sup> Lewis & Elizabeth Myer by Warrant dated the 1 Nov<sup>r</sup> 1792. The piece marked 48<sup>a</sup> 82<sup>p</sup> is now claim'd by Peter Zaner & was surveyed by James Scull deceased.
