And the Other of them Containing eleven acres and forty perches & the usual allowance & ca. The piece marked A. Situate in Martick Township. and the piece marked B. Situate in Drumore Township. Lancaster County. Being parts of a larger Tract. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant. granted to John Robinson. bearing Date the 21<sup>st</sup> March A. D. 1794. Surveyed the above described two pieces of Land. for the Administrators of John Robinson. Deceased the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1830 - as part of the Estate of Said Deceased.
