Located In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the Several Acts of Assembly relating to Unpatented Lands under Proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of a Warrant dated the 2^d June 1762. Granted to William Reynolds for 50 Acres of Land "On the West side of the Survey of the late John Reynolds and extending to the Northward of the same. Assertained on premises 5th November 1828.

Report. The above Tract is wholly the same as a Tract of 50^{ac} 90^{ps} Survey^d 25th February 1775 on Warrant to Samuel Reynolds dated ~~19th~~ 30th June 1749. & held under said title. Note the part marked B. appears to have been Survey^d 31 July 1792 on Warrant to W^m Campbell for 12^{ac} dated 4 Oct^r 1774 & on an Order of the Board of Property dated 4 June 1792. W. S. D.
