



In pursuance of a Warrant, for 400<sup>as</sup> dated the 21<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1794. was surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 1817 for Christian Rosen the above described Tract of Land containing 419 acres 2 perches and allowance of six per Cent. for Roads &c. and that the same was divided as above stated Between Lewis Thickston, & Joseph Clark the Assignees of the said Christian Rosen. for the purpose of obtaining separate Patents & at the time of making said survey the said Lewis Thickston was in possession of the same and there appeared upwards of 25 acres of Land cleared and fenced & a house fit for the habitation of man. situate in Venango Township Crawford County Pennsylvania.
