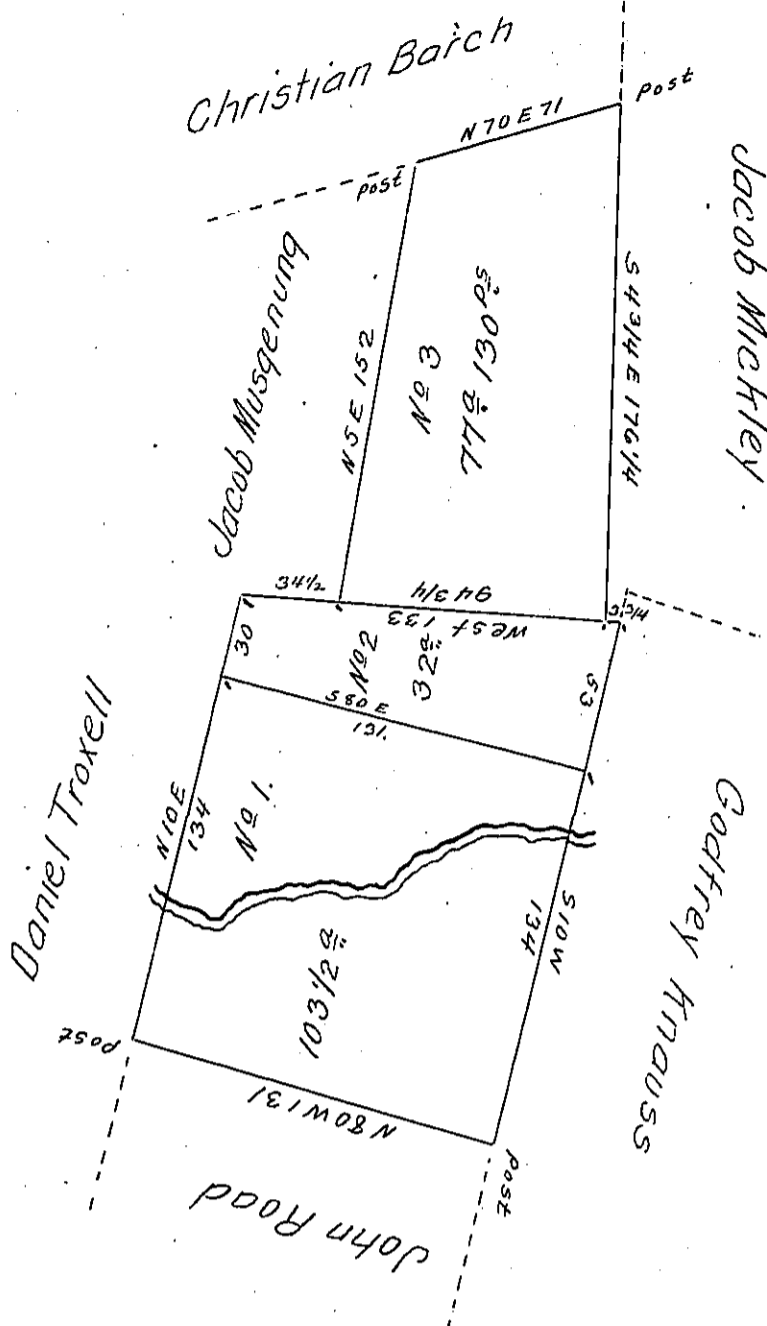

The above are Draughts of three several Tracts of Land situate in Southwhitehall Township in the county of Lehigh containing together two hundred and thirteen Acres fifty perches & allowance of 6th Cent & c. now belonging to Jacob Saeger. Laid together from the original Draughts the 29th day of March 1828.
