Containing one hundred and forty one acres Seventy two perches and the allowance proportioned at Six per Cent for roads &c. Situate on the Waters of Sewickly- in formerly Mount pleasant now Unity township in the County of Westmoreland. Surveyed January 27 th 1829.
