



A Draught of 177^o 54 perches of Land with allowance of six per cent for Roads & c. Situate in Granville Township Mifflin County Penna. part of two Original surveys - No. 1 is 86^o 52¹/₂ part of 103^o 151^{ps} surveyed 31st August 1768, in pursuance of an Order of Survey to James Longwell, No. 983 dated August 26th 1766. No. 2 is 91^o 1¹/₂ perches part of 174^o 7^{ps} surveyed Oct. 26th 1767 on Application No. 2329 granted to James Armstrong dated January 12th 1767. Examined Feb. 14th 1855 for Mrs Mary Minehart the Heir of Francis Thompson and Robert Matthews who are the present owners, and desire a patent for the same The dotted lines inside the survey show the divisions between the different owners
