



A Draught of a Tract of land called "Batchelors Hall," situate on the southerly side of the North East Branch of Susq.^a River between Roaring creek and Catauwassey about a mile from said N. E. a. s. t. branch in the County of Northumberland joining land surveyed for Fred^k Mampolt containing two hundred and three acres and one hundred and fifty perches besides the usual allowance of 6 p. 6 cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 16th day of November 1773 for Matthias Marris in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 9th day of June, 1773.
