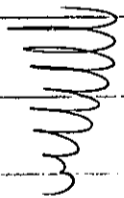

Brown, and above land of L. Stewart, in Northampton County, containing two hundred and ninety-three acres and one half and the usual allowance of six per Cent for roads for Mary Hennessy
