



In pursuance of an order from the Secretary there was surveyed for Robert Miller Esq. a Water Lot Eastward of Carlisle Town bounded Southward by a twenty foot alley of said Town extended to Detort Spring, Westward by East Street, Northward by a Lot said to be granted to Stephen Folk, and Eastward by Detort Spring, containing in length from East to West by the said Alley one hundred and six and eight feet, and by the Lot above said two hundred and forty feet, and in breadth North and South on East Street one hundred and twenty feet and on Detort Spring one hundred and twenty eight feet
