



In Pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the twentieth day of February 1817 granted to James Reed for himself and in trust for Basel Burges according to their Respective Intrests in the same was surveyed on the seventh day of May A.D. 1817 The above described tract of land containing 408 acres 98 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c. situated in Shenango township, Crawford county, and at the time of making the same, James Reed was residing thereon, and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of twenty acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, ~~and that the same was divided as above stated, between~~
