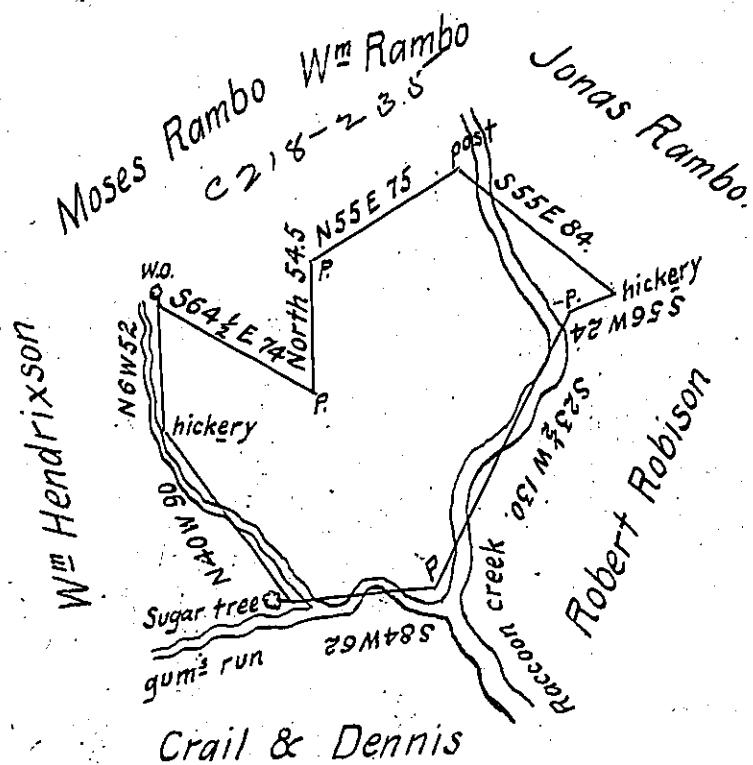

February 11<sup>th</sup> 1836 I John Martin D.S. in and for the County of Beaver do hereby Certify that on the above date I surveyed the above described tract of land for Joseph Rambo on his actual settle- Raccoon Township, Beaver County Including part of Raccoon Creek adjoining lands as above Stated Containing one <sup>and fifteen acres</sup> hundred & fifty eight perches usual allowance of 6 pr. ct.

June 21<sup>st</sup> 1836 the Warrant received and entered for the Land above represented bearing date May the 20<sup>th</sup> 1836 for one hundred and seventeen acres and ninety perches for said Warrant the application was made on ~~S~~ Account of an early survey that had been made; And now I apply the warrant to the survey that I made as above stated Including one hundred and fifteen acres and fifty eight perches with the usual allowance of 6 pr.
