Passed the 24th day of February 1785 entitled "An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Common Wealth," and by order of the Surveyor Gen^l with the approbation of the Hon^l the Executive Council I have Surveyed on the 16th July 1785 the above discribed Tract of two hundred Acres of Land and Allowance of Six P.C^t for Roads &c.
