


IN PURSUANCE of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 27th. day of January 1734 Survey'd unto Thomas Smedley on the 10th day of February then next Ensuing A Certain Tract or parcel of Land Situate in Willis-Town in Chester County, Beginning at a post at a Corner of Anthony Wayne's Land thence by the same - E.N.E. 60 pches to a post, thence 32^d 30' East 58 pds. to a post, thence W.S.W. by the Land of the sd. Thomas Smedley 70 pds. to a post thence N.N.W. by the Land of William Burge 57 pches to the place of Beginning Containing twenty two acres & the usual allowance for Roads.
