



By VIRTUE of a warrt. from the Hon^{ble}. Proprietaries bearing Date the Sixteenth Day of August Anno Dom /1738 I have Survey'd and Laid out unto John Scott in the Township of Hopewell in the County of Lancaster on the west Side Susquehanna river Two hundred acres of Land with allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent Beginning a Black Oak Thence South Sixty Degrees Easterly Two hundred and twelve perches to a post Thence South thirty Degrees Westerly One hundred and Sixty $\frac{1}{2}$ ches to a Post Thence North Sixty Deg^s Westerly Two hundred and twelve $\frac{1}{2}$ ches to a Post Thence North Thirty Degrees Easterly One hundred and Sixty $\frac{1}{2}$ ches to the place of Beginning.
