Draught of one hundred and twenty two acres and Seventy seven perches of land with six per Cent. for roads, Situate formerly in Lack township, in Cumberland county, now in Millford township, in Mifflin county, which is part of a tract of land surveyed 6th June 1763, in pursuance of two Warrants, the one to Richard Rankin dated 4th Feb^y 1755, and the other to John Hunter dated 1st April 1755, said to contain 431 3/4^a, which appears to have been divided 11th April 1801. Resurveyed the above part 14th June 1811, at the request of Jacob Kepner, who appears to be the present owner.
