



Note the whole of the above Survey of George Rife Contains, 424 1/2 a 8c, and appears to have been returned into the Surveyor General's Office by Alexander McClean, Esquire. In pursuance of George Rife's Warrant for 400 a dated the 10th day of January 1785. But by Virtue of a purchase made by Jacob Lehmer, Junr of a part of the Survey of George Rife, there was Surveyed off to him on the 15th day of April 1811, the quantity of 211 1/2 a 8c all, which the said Lehmer, wishes to Patent exclusive of the other part of George Rife Agreeable to the division line 8c.

Situate on the waters of Coxes Creek in Millford Township (now) Somerset County and Surveyed as aforesaid at the Instance and request of the Owner, who I expect will forward his title papers with this return.
