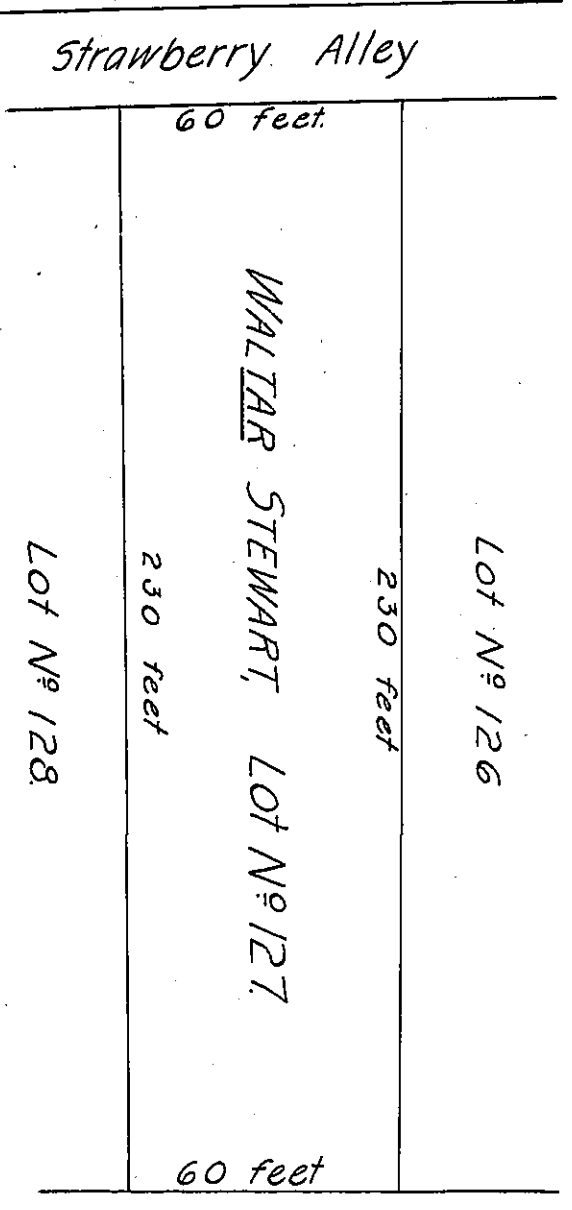


FORM No. 1.



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772, a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, marked in a General Plan of said Town, Number One hundred and Twenty Seven. Containing in Breadth East and West on Dewberry Street, Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Southward by Dewberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Twenty Six, Northward by Strawberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and Twenty Eight. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 22<sup>d</sup> day of December 1774 for Walter Stewart by Warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-second day of October 1906.
