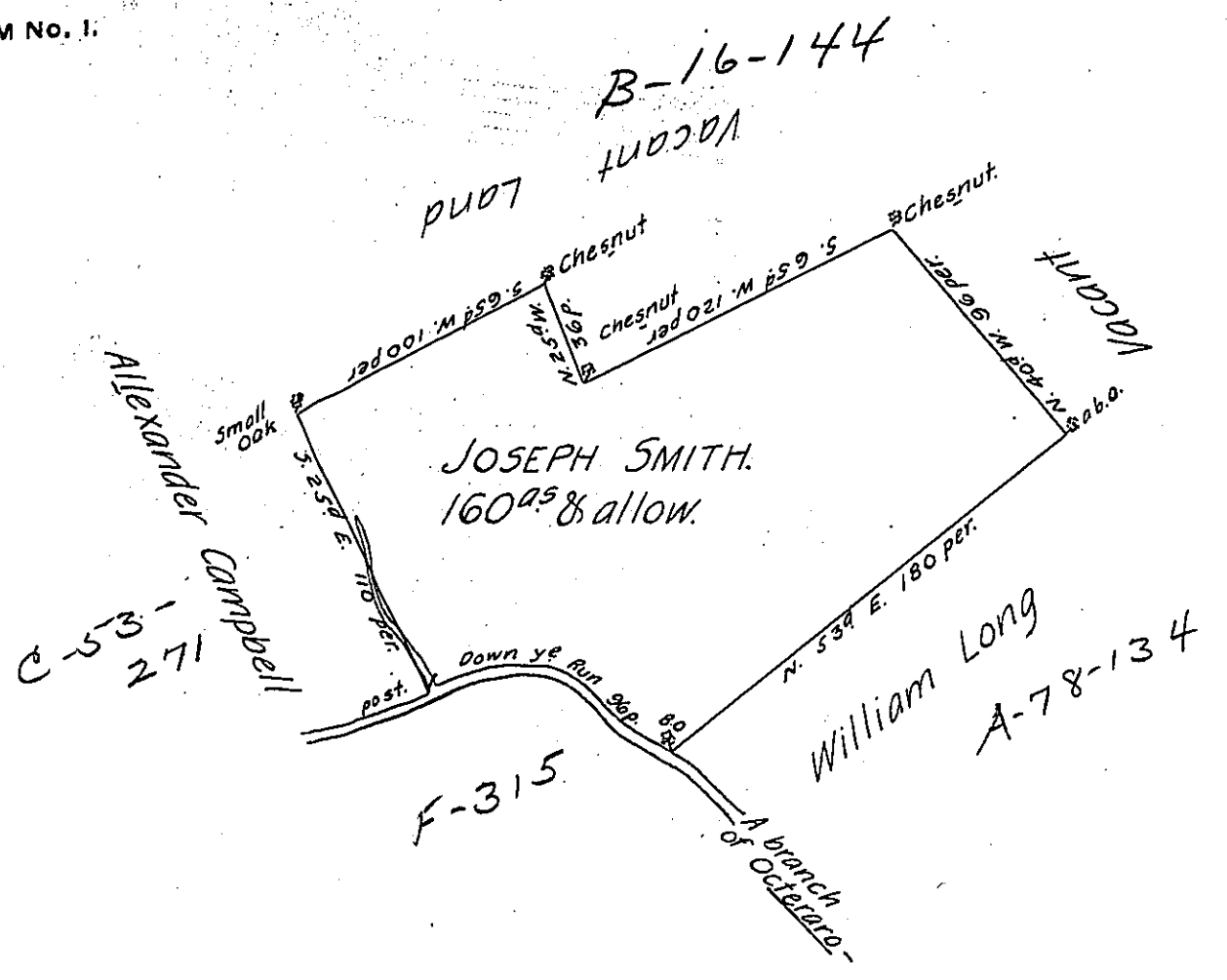


FORM NO. 1.



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 19th of March Anno Domini 1739. The above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed to Joseph Smith in Sadsbury Township, and Lancaster County. Beginning at a post by a Small Branch of Octararo Cree^k, thence Down the Same on the Several Courses thereof 96 perches to a black Oak &^e. Containing One Hundred and Sixty acres, beside ^{ye} Allowance for Roads.
