



A Draught of a Tract of Land Containing Thirty three Acres and Allowance of Six $\frac{7}{8}$ Cent &c^a Situate in Nockamixon Township Bucks County. (Being part of Two hundred & fifty Eight Acres $\frac{1}{2}$, and Sixty One perches & Allowance &c^a -

Surveyed the 27th day of November 1765, to Herman Jungen in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 3^d day of March 1737, granted to Benjamin Foreman.

Divided in the Surveyor General's Office at the Request of Arthur Erwine & Christopher Seigefoose.

Returned into the Secretary's Office the 31st December 1774, by Warrant granted to Christopher Sigafous and Arthur Irwine.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-sixth day of October 1906.
