



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on both sides of the great road leading from Francis Yarnells to Fort Augusta adjoining. Surveyed for Joseph Shippen, junr Esqr and John McNairs land about Six or Seven Miles from Fort Augusta, in Northumberland County. Containing three hundred & ten Acres, and One hundred & six perches, besides the usual allowance of 6 Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of June 1774, for James Shaw. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of August 1773.
