



Pursuant to a Warrant from the Proprietaries bearing Date the 29th Day of October, in the Year of our Lord 1776. Survey'd unto Michael Shlyer a Tract of Land situate in the Township of Springfield, in the County of Bucks, called & known by the Name of the Rocky-Spring, according to the Metes, Bounds and Land Marks specify'd in the above Draught, and containing fifty Acres & three Quarters of one Acre, and Allowance of six Acres $\frac{3}{4}$ Cent.
