Forty three Acres and Ninety perches and the Usual Allowance, is part of a Tract of five hundred Acres. Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrants bearing date the 5th of November Anno Domini 1714. Granted unto Alexander Ross &c. The remainder, is part of two hundred and eight acres, Surveyed in Pursuance of two Warrants, the one bearing date the 1st of April Anno Domini 1749, and The other the 11th of April A.D 1750. Granted unto William Orr, Surveyed the 15th of June A. D, 1809, for William Brown.
