



The above is a draught of a survey made the 20th of ~~March~~ April, 1816, in pursuance of a warrant granted James Roney (in trust for the heirs of Marculus Roney decd) dated the 20th of February 1816; called the Crooked-lot. Situate on the dividing ridge between the waters of Wheeling and Buffaloe in Findley and Donegal townships in Washington county, containing fifty eight acres, and twenty nine perches with the usual allowance.
